Objectives of the ACADEMY

- VIII. To provide guidance and support to other organizations who may wish to carry out similar activities.
- I. To build an institution dedicated to the cause of disseminating and spreading knowledge and information about Acupressure and Acupuncture and other drugless therapies.

The institution visualized has been created as Academy for Acupressure and Acupuncture. It was registered on 2nd February 2012 and was formally inaugurated on 11th March 2012

A building has been hired since September 2012 to conduct the activities. To spread the knowledge and understanding of the advantages of Acupressure and Acupuncture, regular training programmes are being conducted.

The Advance Acupuncture Courses are being conducted wherein prospective practitioners are given a thorough understanding of the science of Acupuncture and certain other drugless therapies. This course is primarily meant for those who wish to practice Acupuncture in a professional way. Monthly meetings are held regularly wherein the observations and experiences of

healers/doctors are shared and doubts clarified. This forum has proved to be very useful.

II. To develop new and simple methods to manage various health problems.

Dr. Bhojraj's Method of Acupuncture/ Acupressure is simple, easy to practice and effective in providing relief and cure for almost all types of ailments/diseases. The best part of Dr. Bhojraj's Method is that almost all the points for treatment are below the elbows and the knees. The needles need to be pierced to a depth of **0.1mm only**. The third advantage of this technique is the duration of treatment is only 5 minutes or less at each sitting.

All those who have undergone the course agree that Dr. Bhojraj's method of teaching makes this science very simple and easy to understand. Since the subject is based on scientific explanation, all those who have completed the course are very successful in their practice.

Seminar on Touch Heal Therapy

Our Academy had invited the faculty of the Cumbam Academy of Acupuncture to conduct a Seminar on **Touch Heal Therapy** in Bangalore from 6th to 8th December, 2013. Twenty six participants attended the Seminar. Dr. Bhojraj's Method of Acupuncture has reduced the number of needles used for treatment from over a dozen to just 4. He was very keen that the therapists learn this more simple technique of touching just a **single point** to cure diseases.

Healer Momammed Meera Bose and Healer P.M. Umar Farook conducted the sessions. The participants were taught to read the pulse at a single acu-point and diagonise the problem. Based on these observations, a single acu-point is chosen for treatment. The treatment involves only touching the acu-point for a few seconds. But above all this, they insisted on "Assimilation" and "Eliminations".

Dorn Therapy

The **first Dorn Therapy** in Karnataka was conducted on 10th & 11th January, 2015, in **Bengaluru.** Practitioners associated with our Academy were given an opportunity to attend this certificate course which was conducted by **Dr. Subhas Mani**, the **first Certified Dorn Tutor** in India.

Any **misalignment** in the vertebrae causes blockages in the flow of energy to different organs of the body which result in various ailments/diseases. Fourteen practitioners attended this course. All of them appreciated the indepth knowledge of Dr. Subhas Mani and his **excellent presentation** of the course.

III. To conduct systematic studies and collect data for research and analysis.

Systematic studies are being conducted on various aspects of several ailments. To this end, it has now been proved that Migraine Headache can be completely cured with acupuncture. One of our practitioners from the medical fraternity has conducted systematic study and has prepared a dissertation which is being submitted to the Medicina Alternativa, Sri Lanka, for the award of a Ph.D. degree.

At the Academy, we have the data, accumulated over the past 3 years of some 3,000+ patients, of different ailments. The accumulated data is being analysed and will be presented in the forthcoming Seminars/Workshops/Conferences.

One significant achievement of our Academy is the conduct of an International Workshop on Pulse Metabolic Analyser (PMA) developed by Dr. Sergey Fedotov of Russia during November 2014.

To this end, The Academy has organized a Workshop (November 2014) to get a better understanding of the Pulse Metabolic Analyser developed by Dr. Sergey Fedotov (Russia) which is considered as a very good tool to measure the energy levels in different organs of the body.

The PMA devised by Dr. Fedotov has the capability of recording the levels of *Vata*, *Pitta* and *Kapha*, which is very useful for Ayurveda doctors. Similarly, the PMA has the capability of recording the Asid-Base (Alkali) balance of which is very helpful for the practitioners of Homoeopathy.

This Workshop has encouraged many healers/doctors to own the PMA and use very effectively in treating various ailments/diseases.

Based on the experience of treating patients using the PMA, which measures every type of energy in each of the major 12 organs of the body, very positive indications are observed in the health condition of the patients. Such observations/recordings will help in proving the efficacy and advantages of Acupuncture.

IV. To net-work and co-operate with other organizations of similar nature to undertake joint campaigns, actions and programmes etc.

A beginning has been made in this direction. Dr. Bhojraj was invited to train practitioners of Ayurveda in Acupressure. National Integrated Medical Association, Bengaluru, organized this programme to bring awareness of the advantages of Acupressure among practitioners of Ayurveda. During early 2014, a specially designed course in Acupressure was conducted. This course was highly appreciated by the participants. As a follow up, a group discussion was organized

during June 2014. The feed-back received has been very encouraging. Many of the Ayurveda practitioners indicated that when Acupressure was combined with Ayurveda while treating certain ailments, they observed much quicker recovery and all the patients felt more relaxed.

Dr. H. Bhojraj was invited to train 17 practitioners of Nambudri's Allergy Elimination Technique (NAET – a drugless therapy) in Bangalore in 2012. All the members of this group had a medical background and some of them were Post Graduates in Homoeopathy, Ayurveda and Nursing. The group appreciated the course and all of them have expressed their heartfelt thanks for having received guidance in these effective techniques to overcome problems of various ailments and even serious diseases using the advanced Acupuncture technique developed by Dr. Bhojraj.

Training of the practitioners of NAET is another step in this direction.

A Memorandum of Understanding has been signed with Swami Vivekananda Yoga Anusandhan Sanstan, Bengaluru (S-VYASA) - a deemed University, to take up joint programmes of training and research in the field of Drugless Therapies.

Efforts have been initiated to approach the State Government to give recognition to Acupuncture/Acupressure as a means of easy and

cost effective cure/prevention for different diseases/ailments.

VI. To interact with the State, Universities, Scientific bodies and other institutions/organizations involved in spreading the knowledge of these therapies.

Our Academy has been bringing out quarterly publication titled "Acu Wellness" since October 2012. This publication has received very good response from the general public practitioners. This quarterly publication is aimed publicising the achievements through Acupuncture in treating various ailments is an easy to follow process. Each issue is primarily focused on publicising case histories. Each issue of this publication contains some general information about different ailments/problems/organs of the human body which could be easily understood by commoners. The Acupuncture treatments available for these treatments are indicated.

We have a separate website "acupressureclub.org" wherein general information of Acupressure and acupuncture are included. All the issues of Acu Wellness are uploaded into this website. It also serves the purpose of informing the readers of all our training and other special programmes regularly.

This website is being visited by many people and is gaining popularity. A good number of patients have been contacting us after looking at our website. This website is also drawing the attention of those who are on the lookout for simple and easy methods to solve their health problems. We are being contacted regularly by many visitors to this website who are evincing keen interest in knowing about the drugless therapies. A good number of them have enrolled themselves to our Advance Acupuncture Course and have been giving treatments to others for various ailments successfully after completing successfully the course.

VII. To design and publicise different programmes and activities of the ACADEMY in the public domain through website.

A modest beginning has been made in this direction. Members of the Karnataka Acupuncture Association have evinced keen interest in Dr. Bhojraj's Method of Acupuncture.

FUTURE PLANS

Get recognition from the Central and State Governments for this Scientific treatment of Acupressure and Acupuncture.

Our Academy is in touch with organisations in this aspect. The Academy has been in contact with many institutions with similar objectives as ours. Certain organisations and some individuals are in touch with us and actions are moving in a positive direction.

Have our own campus to accommodate outpatient treatment facility, Facilities to impart training / Technology for 100 students.

To this end many efforts have been put in place. Certain individuals have evinced interest in our efforts, particularly in rural areas. Since owning our own facilities in cities is a very expensive proposition, we have begun to identify accredited healers trained by us in different parts of Bengaluru city. Also, the Academy has identified some individual practitioners to carry out the functions of training and treatments in some other states also.

An auditorium with a seating capacity of 200 people to hold seminars, Workshops etc.

The search for a location is on. This **ambitious project** will require funds to the tune of Rs. **355 lakhs**, a major portion of which we hope to generate through generous donations from philanthropists, NGOs, business houses etc. The **seed money required is Rs. 35 lakhs.**

Pulse Metabolic Analyser (PMA) Workshop on 16th November, 2014

Being a scientist, it has always been **Dr. Bhojraj**'s endeavor to explain things scientifically.

Dr. Sergey Fedotov is the originator of the PMA. He is the Principal of the Pulse Academy, Russia, which he started in the year 1998 after nearly 2 decades of research.

Our Academy invited Dr. Sergey Fedotov to conduct a Workshop on his invention. This Workshop turned out to be the **first** ever session conducted by Dr. Fedotov in the world.

The scientific quest to prove the Chinese system of pulse evaluation motivated the healers to join together in this **Workshop**. Dr. Sergey Fedotov's Pulse Metabolic Analyser (PMA) was the topic and Dr. Fedotov's PMA has been well accepted all over the world for pulse evaluation.



This Workshop was conducted on 16th November, 2014. The presentation to maintain good health by Dr. Fedotov was very interesting which touched mainly on the food we eat, how to eat and when to eat. The stomach is the first thing to be taken care of if you want to stay healthy.



The next session was on demonstration of Pulse Metabolic Analysis which was well interpreted by Dr. Fedotov and doubts were partially cleared.

The theoretical aspects of energy and its origin were presented. This formed the basis for energy treatment for any physical or psychological problems.

Pulse analysis was carried out for some participants and interpretations were discussed Participants were explained how to interpret the energy graphs. The corrections can be done by manipulation with acupuncture, Homeopathy, Ayurveda or food supplements.




Dr, B.S. Venkateshwara Rao explained how he interpreted the PMA for giving relief and cure for various diseases through Homeopathy. He takes the help of the *Qi* graph to determine the polarity and the *Vata*, *Pitta*, *Kapha* analyses is equated to the 3 miasims.

This Workshop enabled all the participants get a better understanding of all the information generated by the PMA. Interpretation of this information makes treatment easy and effective. It quantifies the energies before and after treatment. By comparing these reports, one can find out what changes have taken place in the patient's energy levels.

This gives the proof and the **scientific basis** for recognition of the effectiveness of this method of treatment.

Participants included those who came from as far as Nepal and Iran. The list of participants from Gujarat, Maharashtra, M.P., A.P., T.N. and from neighboring Mysore. There were not only Acupuncturists but also practitioners of Ayurveda and Homeopathy - all of them seeking to have a better understanding of the Pulse Analyser.

More than 10 participations came forward to buy the Analyser. They had a meeting with Dr. Fedotov on the 17th for further clarifications. Dr. Fedotov left on 18th after a pleasant and productive visit to Bangalore.
